- v. To generate awareness among the unemployed youth about the industry demand for various vocations/trades, project future demand of industry at District level;

- vii. To train and create a pool of trainers in various trades across the Districts to facilitate the implementation of various skill development initiatives of the Central and State Government;
- viii. To explore and make use of digital technology to facilitate and enable improvement of learning outcome of the training.

To organize and conduct counselling sessions for skilled youth and vocational graduates of the District with regard to awareness of various schemes and programmes of the Central and State Government and the process of registration on portals like National Career Services (NCS) portal, Labour Market Information System (LMIS) portal and
