- iii. To work as District level focal points and local facilitator for ensuring and a sustaining skill nourishing initiatives at the District level.
- iv. To assess the nature and magnitude of the skill gap across the District and suggest appropriate measures in terms of vocational or other training to bridge the gap.
- v. To generate awareness among the unemployed youths about the industry demand for various vocations/trade, project future demand of the industry at District level.
- vi. To suggest/explore methods in order to increase livelihood opportunities across the District and facilitate enhanced job creation.
- vii. To train and create a pool of trainers in various trades across the District to facilitate the implementation of various skill development initiatives of the Central and State Government.
